VACCINATION

Measles is on the rise

You may have seen from the news that there is a rise in the number of measles cases in England. The MMR vaccine is the safest and most effective way to protect against Measles, Mumps and Rubella. If you are unsure whether you have previously had the vaccine or not, please check with our nursing team.

Shingles vaccinations

From 1st September Shingles vaccinations will be offered to those turning 70 and 65 years on or after 1st September 2023.

All Immunocompromised individuals aged 50 years and over (no upper age limit) will be offered the vaccination.

Please check with reception or nurses as to whether you are eligible.

We are currently organising our flu appointments and hoping to start the campaign at the end of September.

We will contact all eligible patients as soon as the appointments are in place and we have secured the vaccine delivery date.

Winter Covid Vaccinations

We will be starting Winter Covid Vaccinations in Mid October.

They will be offered to the following patients:

- residents in a care home for older adults
- all adults aged 65 years and over.
- persons aged 6 months to 64 years in a clinical risk group
- frontline health and social care workers
- persons aged 12 to 64 years who are household contacts, of people with immunosuppression (As per the Green book chapter 14A, available online)
- persons aged 16 to 64 years who are carers, and staff working in care homes for older adults (As per the Green book chapter 14A, available online)
