


Wickham Market Medical Centre & Rendlesham Surgery Spring Newsletter

We are closed Friday 3rd April, Monday 6th April, Monday 4th May and Monday 25th May due to bank holidays.






Please also be aware due to staff training we are closed from 1pm on the following days: Wednesday 14th April and Thursday 14th May.

Eligible Cohorts for Spring 2026

Vaccinations will be offered to:

- Adults aged 75 years and over.
- Residents in care homes for older adults.
- Individuals aged 6 months and over who are immunosuppressed.

All eligible patients will be contacted and offered an appointment between the 13th April to the 30th June.
